

- Companies will present the team with a current business challenge in the form of a challenge statement.
- Companies will be required for a maximum of 2 hours on each of the programme days and must be available to arrange a 3 hour company visit for your team(s) on the final morning of the programme (9:30am-12:30pm).
- Company reps must attend 3 training sessions, during these sessions our expert facilitators, Big Motive, will train your reps in Design Thinking and building Creative Confidence through which they will develop and set your company challenge statement. The reps will also receive training in effective communication skills, safeguarding & child protection.
