Coaches

We are seeking to engage several coaches to work alongside the Generation Innovation project team to fulfil the following responsibilities:

- Attend and support the delivery and facilitation of the work experience programme (In-person)
- Support teams to achieve a solution through Design Thinking methodology
- Support teams to create a prototype solution to the company challenge
- Support teams in preparing a pitch to present to senior management
- Attend virtual Coach training (a 2-hour session in May)
- Complete Access NI check
- Assist the Project team in other areas that may be required to achieve the targets and deliverables of the programme

Programme Dates

We will require up to 5 coaches for each of the weeks listed below (this may be increased to 10 coaches required for Belfast). Applicants must be available from 9-5 pm each day.
